Arrangements are as follows :

- 11.00 am Gather on the drive up to the Castle. People can be dropped off at this location but there is NO PARKING on the drive or in the Castle grounds. (The barrier will be dropped once the march has left the location).
- 11.30 am Commence march to Eden Court Theatre. On arrival gather for the demonstration at the location indicated by the duty Police Officers.

PLEASE NOTE:

Stop Highland Windfarms Campaign is grateful to Highland Council and the Police for their help in accommodating our requests for the march start point and route. Please ensure that the march is orderly, no litter is dropped and the public is not inconvenienced.

The Police have asked that we move as a single unit along the route in order to minimise disruption to traffic and pedestrians.

Where a number of people are coming from one group, please appoint a person as steward and ensure they are identified by wearing a hi-vis jacket. Further information on stewarding will be circulated in good time for the event.

Parking: The upper floors of Rose Street car park provide the best value and are less busy than the Eastgate Centre car parks. Rose Street car park is accessed from Longman Road (the main road into town from the Kessock Bridge roundabout). There is metered parking (quite cheap for several hours) on Culduthel Road but take care not to park in the "Permit only" area. As it's a Saturday there may be parking in the Council car park at the back of Eden Court. Also there may be some spaces available at Eden Court Theatre.
